Reducing Stress, Dealing with Differences, Building Community: Character is the Answer!

The COVID19 Pandemic has presented numerous challenges to society in general and to the education community in particular. The level of stress and anxiety is at an all-time high as both students and adults grapple with the challenges presented by remote learning, the return to school, and mental health concerns. The climate in our society has also been a challenge, and students must learn how to navigate that climate and learn how to effectively deal with differences in opinions, beliefs, and backgrounds. Students, teachers, and parents need to feel a sense of engagement if their schools are to be effective. This sense of community in schools has been challenged by remote learning, return the school, and the ongoing safety concerns presented by the pandemic.

This NJASECD webinar will provide some programmatic responses to these challenges through a series of six breakout sessions on a variety of subjects which are timely to the issues listed above. The webinar will begin with a keynote discussion moderated by Nathan Fisher, featuring Phil Brown and Maurice Elias who will speak about their journey with Character Education and Social-Emotional Learning in New Jersey.
